Degree and PhD in Psychology and Speech & Language Therapist from the University of Barcelona. She has taught and researched at several universities (UB, UNED, UOC) and since 2001 she is a Senior Lecturer at the University of the Balearic Islands. She has won two awards of research in Language and Speech therapy 'Jordi Perelló' at the Catalan Speech and Language Therapist professional College.

She currently holds the positions of Director of the Institute for Educational Research and Innovation, coordinator of the Education PhD program at this university, as well as academic secretary of the International Association for the Study of Language Acquisition (AEAL). She is also director of the Laboratory of Research in Development, Education and Language and principal investigator of the I+DEL research group of the



Educational Research Institute (IRIE UIB-GOB). She has a long history of university management which includes the secretary of the Faculty of Education, and the Deputy Dean of the Department of Applied Pedagogy and Educational Psychology, as well as Director of several studies of the UIB.

She has recognized two research periods (each of six years, the last one in 2016) and four teaching periods (each of 5 years). Her research has focused on language acquisition, language difficulties, bilingualism, and phonology. She is the author of 45 papers published in indexed Journals, 22 of them indexed in JCR, in addition to being the author of 48 books and book chapters including several evaluation tests. She has also participated in 134 national and international conferences, 12 of them as an invited speaker.

In addition, she is Associate editor of Frontiers in Psychology (JCR) & Revista de Logopedia, Foniatría y audiología (Scopus). Their peer-review work included 72 Peerand 21 review in Journals papers edited: https://publons.com/researcher/1225411/eva-aguilar-mediavilla/peer-review/.
