Dr. Alonso has published over 800 scientific original articles, revisions and books(1996-currently): 717 original articles indexed in Web of Science (73,293 Sum of Times Cited) and an h-index of 123(Publons-WOS). Mentioned by Clarivate Analytics/Thomson Reuters, for seven consecutive years, as "Highly Cited Researcher in the World" in the field of Psychiatry/ Psychology(from 2016 until 2022) and as one of the scientist included into the list of the most cited over the world (World's Top 2% Scientists) made by the Stanford Univ. Jordi Alonso, Dr Medicine (1990, Barcelona Univ.), specialist in Prev. Med. and Public Health (2003) and in Family and Community Med. (1985) is coordinator of Health Services Res.group,IMIM (Hospital del Mar Medical Research Institute), Barcelona, Spain. Dr Alonso is Deputy Scientific Director of CIBERESP since 2019. He is also full professor (Public Health) at the Pompeu Fabra Univ. (UPF), and Assoc.faculty, at the Bloomberg School of Pub. Health,Johns Hopkins Univ(JHU), Baltimore, MD, US. Director, Program of Res.in Epidemiol. and Public Health, IMIM (2011-2023).

Dr. Alonso's group is part of the CIBER Epidemiología y Salud Pública (ISCIII), where it has been recognised an "Excellent group" (since 2018 to present). Also recognised a "Consolidated Research Group- SGR" by AGAUR, Generalitat de Catalunya, since 1977.

Dr Alonso RESEARCH LINES:

1. BURDEN OF MENTAL DISORDERS: Dr Alonso studies the frequency, risk factors, disabilities, economic and social costs related to common mental disorders and suicide. As part of the World Mental Health (WMH) Surveys, a consortium of 30+ countries, where Dr Alonso is member of the Steering Committee, European scientific coordinator, and leads the Work Group on Burden of Disease, and co-leads the International College Surveys (ICS).

During this period, Dr Alonso has published international data of undertreatment of anxiety disorders (only 10% of cases receive minimally adequate treatment worldwide), barriers to treatment and perceived benefit of treatment. During the COVID pandemic he obtained competitive funding (MINDCOVID project) to launch one of the largest and representative cohort studies in healthcare workers and the general population and have reported about prevalence and trajectories of mental disorders and suicidal ideation and published over 20

papers. He also obtained competitive funding to: assess mental disorders evaluate of mental health interventions among univ. students (PROMES-U) and to evaluate and improve methods to assess the impact of mental disorders. Finally, Dr. Alonso has launched an emergent line of research focusing on improving the personalized management of suicide risk through the development of data-driven (e-health records RWD) and user-oriented clinical decision support systems (CODIRISC, PERMANENS and RECIPROC).

2. PROMs (Patient-Reported Outcomes Measures). Dr Alonso is the co-scientific director, BiblioPRO, the largest online library of PROMS in Spanish, with almost 30,000 registered users, and 57,671 visits in 2022. BiblioPRO is now accredited as an official platform of CIBER. Dr Alonso continue advancing methods and applications of PROMS in collaboration with ISOQOL (International Society for Quality of Life Research), by whom he was awarded with the 2019 Presidential Award; with PROMIS (PRO Health Information System), where he was president of the International Committee and member of the Board of Directors from 2015; and with COSMIN (Consensus-based Standards for the selection of health Measurement Instruments), being a Scientific Committee member from 2012-2022).
